# Professional Life:

Chris had a unique experience as a gang prosecutor in Fresno County. He then worked in Santa Clara County, which is the second largest DA office in CA (120+ prosecutors), where he was assigned to a sexual assault unit for 3+ years, also served in a homicide unit. He moved to Nevada County for affordability and raising his family 2+ years ago. Nevada County only has 11 prosecutors, so it is a challenge to be up to date on all areas of law.
