MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Today's speaker was Roger McCort, an Officer for the Grass Valley region Salvation Army and a Rotarian of our club. He was giving us an update to the Red Kettle/Bell Ringer Christmas Fundraiser for Nevada

A little history first: During WWI, Salvation Army volunteers would bring coffee and

donuts to the trenches. The volunteers also became communication conduits between family and troops. In WWII, they continued this tradition in tents and finally the USO evolved out of these efforts.

The Salvation Army was formed in America in 1883. The region covered was from San Francisco to Reno for just one officer.

On to an update: The Red Kettle Annual Fundraiser started in San Francisco when a Salvation Army Officer wanted to feed the homeless population. He, however, did not have the money to do so, so he put a crab pot out and asked for donations and raised enough to feed a thousand people. He continued this every year and had positive outcomes which in turn led to other Salvation Army sites being created. Thus began the bell ringing program you see today. This program has been in effect for over 130 years.

This year's Red Kettle drive in Nevada County raised \$14,750 and it is believed that there will be more Red Kettle checks arriving. They may hit the set goal of \$15,500!

Our Rotary Club raised \$2118.16 this year, a thousand dollars more than last year. Our club raised \$800.00 more than each of the other area rotary clubs! Great Work!!!

In the last 12 months, over 1500 families received various Salvation Army services. Children were able to go to camps, transitional housing was provided, their Clothing Closet was utilized, and their main building was used for gatherings and meetings.


