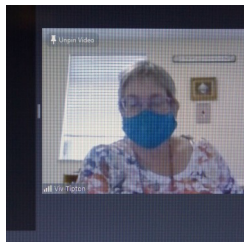
## July 13, 2020 Club News

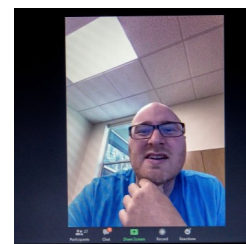
