Notable meeting date will be the visit of the District Governor on July 16.

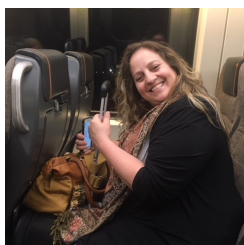
**Tim McCall** needs updates on member makeups for the month of May. Please contact him.

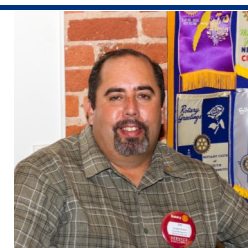
