- Blake introduced the Union Hill Broadcasting Network team, who shared some about the equipment and supplies they have been able to recently acquire thanks in part to funding from our club.



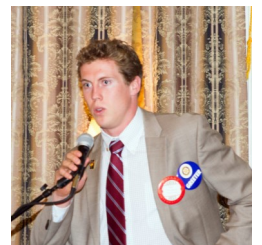
