Students of the month from Lyman Gilmore were honored today. The Principle is thankful for the support of Rotary and for being recognized in the community.

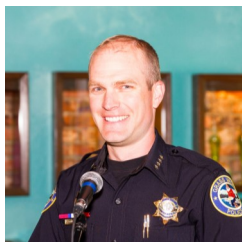

and labor trafficking are the two kinds of trafficking. Labor trafficking exist mainly with immigrants looking for work and in our community within the Cannabis industry. We showed a video of a girl named Holly who was 14 when she was trafficked. She was a normal 14 year old girl that was looking for attention and affirmation. She was lured in by an older young man and was in human trafficking for 36 hours before she was found by law enforcement. Transitional age youth are not well counted for but are at risk and can get lost in the system. Human trafficking generates \$150 billion worldwide. 75% of victims that are trafficked are women and girls. Locally there is a lot of collaboration between law enforcement, Communities Beyond Violence, and local health care. Hospitals are the top place to help ID victims. 80% of victims say they had an encounter with a health care provider while trafficked mainly in the Emergency Department or in the Family Birthing Center. Dignity Health has taken on a big initiative to train health care providers to help recognize the signs and connect victims to services. If you see something say something.
