- Work force housing being built in Penn Valley, Nevada City and Truckee
- Cannabis
- Homelessness

Government Funds coming thru American Rescue? Plan – ½ this year and ½ next year 19.3 mil.

30% community 70% government (discussion with question from Seth at end as to why so little community, complicated answer including grants already given to businesses, etc)

Confirmation of eligibility to be determined once Treasury Guidelines are released.

1.9 Trillion coronavirus relief fund direct to county and cities ½ and ½

Back into community with county costs recovered, including revenue loss and economic funds received; plan to leverage funds for matches

- ◇ Juvenile Hall admin area being renovated to house Dispatch Center. It's being moved from Correctional Area. Any juvenile needs, very few, are being sent to Placer Co. ADA retrofitting needed in several Areas. Property near current hall will be taken over by the USFS for a new location for their new planned facilities. Eric Rood Center to get generator that will power the Rood Center, Jail, Crown Point, Brighton Green facilities.
