Polio is still close to eradication, but unfortunately there were 14 cases reported recently. Rotary International offers graduate level scholarships in the amount of \$30,000 to work in the Rotary Peace Centers.

Rod finished the program with a request of pledges from the members to ensure the club's contribution goal is met. He also acknowledged the individual members who have made notable contributions to the Rotary Society. There was a good response from the floor, so hopefully the goal has been met.
