The speaker was Scott McFarland, CEO, Western Sierra Scott is a member and previously served on the board. Community Health Centers have grown significantly since Obamacare became law. The numbers of people who would otherwise have difficulty receiving medical care, can now be helped, and not turned away. Clinics served 29 million people nationwide which include vets, retired, ag workers and the homeless. One problem the clinics face now is doctor recruitment. Medicare patients are increasing, so Western Sierra will be building a senior service center in Grass Valley.
