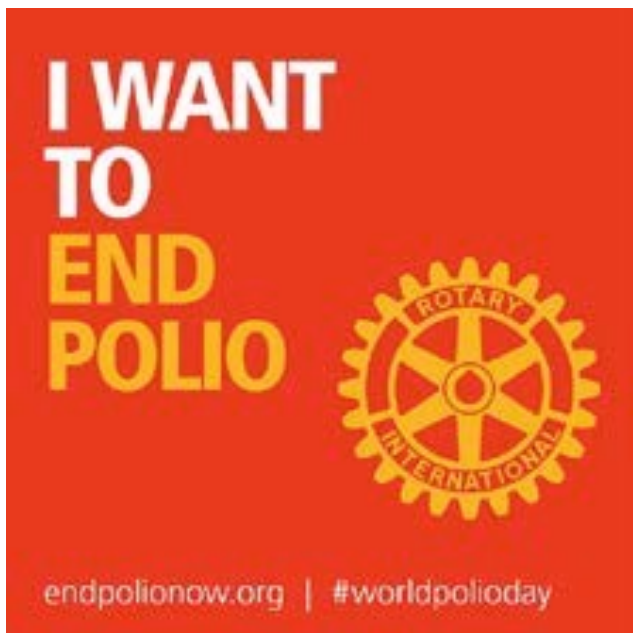
Just in Time for World Polio Day October 24, 2014! Wear your DISTRICT 5190 "we are this close" pin

Guest was Marcus Moore from River Valley Community Bank.



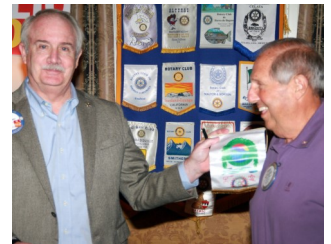
Announcements and Confessions:

- The reason the margarita's were so good is because Scott

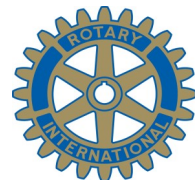
- Browne got the recipe while vacationing in Cancun. He was fined \$50.
