### **MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**

Kimberley Parker, County of Nevada-Economic Development Manager, explained the of Measure V. It is a solution to disaster response in our County via a sales tax increase of 0.5%. This measure is the outcome of a County CEO Roundtable committee recommendation to protect the community via additional defensible space areas, helping seniors and disabled do the same, provide green waste drop-off sites, and more wood chipping programs.



This measure would also support fuel breaks through out the County. The total tax collected revenue of approximately \$12M would be realized and flow into the general fund. How-

ever, safeguards would be put in place to ensure funds were only used for the purposes mentioned. Questions arose as to how to guarantee funds would be earmarked solely for the stated purpose and what future supervisors could change. County Supervisor,
