#### **MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**

Jesse Hartley from College of Ayurveda was our speaker today. What is Ayurveda and how could it help me? Ayurveda is the science and knowledge of life. It is a wholistic health system optimizing wellness.

Jess is trained in disease management in Ayurvedic. She is also an herbalist so she can make individual formulas for clients. Lymphatic massages are also part of the process, as well as acupuncture, and other body work techniques.



This is an elemental science. Jess explained all of the elements of Ayurveda: Vata, Pitta, and Kapha. Jess explained their qualities and what they meant as well as the diet for each type.

Providers will conduct a full health history, including emotional and mental habits. They get to be problem solvers and help optimize people to their best selves.

Jess shared some practices such as using a Neti Pot for sinus issues, colds, and allergies. An eye wash cup can be filled with a saline solution and rose water and used to purify the eyes. Using oil for the skin daily can keep it healthy and younger. Mediation is a wonderful practice to regulate the nervous system.

Breath work is a vehicle for a very healthy life. Jess explained breath work techniques that can alleviate some symptoms associated to many chronic conditions.

Jess works at the Ayurvedic College that recently celebrated its 30th Anniversary and is the first school in the country!


