Dear District 5190 Rotarians,

Many have you have expressed concern for the folks being affected by the terrible King Fire that is still raging.

As of this time, [Cal-Fire](#) is reporting no loss of human life and no loss of homes. Hopefully, that will still be the case at the conclusion of this tragedy. (Sadly, since this was written, homes have been lost to the fire)

Currently, almost 3000 people have been evacuated including some members of both the Pollock-Pines Camino and Georgetown Divide Rotary Clubs. These Rotarians are not certain when they will be allowed back in their homes. I have been, and will continue to be, in contact with members of both clubs. They are thankful for the concern, but have not identified any specific way that we can be of help at this time.

The cleanup and aftermath will require tremendous resources as these communities try to recover. Once the fire is out we will identify how we can best help.

Thank you for your offers of help and concern. I'm certain that your good thoughts and prayers are greatly appreciated.

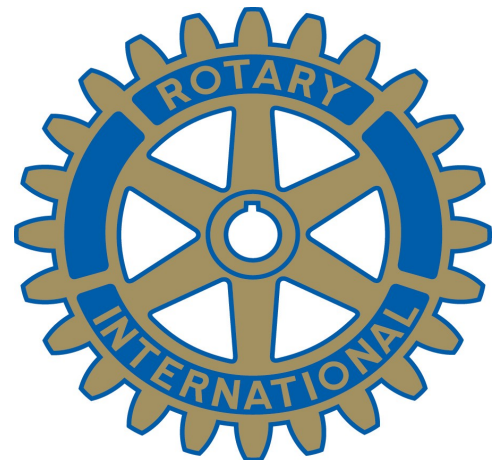
