SOLAR LIGHT PROJECT – STANFORD, SOUTH AFRICA

The Rotary Club of Stanford, South Africa would like to thank you again for your support of this project, and we're pleased to let you know we carried out the first distribution of Solar Lights earlier this week. The children who received the lights are all from an informal settlement just outside of Stanford. They all live in shacks constructed from corrugated iron sheets, bits of wood, etc. Most of these shacks do not have windows and virtually no natural light.

The children were absolutely delighted to have their very own source of light, which means they can now do their homework, study or read without having to revert to the use of candles, which very often lead to shack fires. Here are some photos of this initial distribution.





The lights need initial charging in direct sunlight for a full day, thereafter they can be re-charged daily or as required.
