The Rotary Club of Downtown Sioux Falls is the oldest and largest Rotary Club in South Dakota, and is among the 20 largest Rotary Clubs in North America. It was started on July 1, 1915, at the Cataract Hotel by 42 business leaders who wished to have a place to socialize weekly. They were introduced to the new Rotary International organization started by Paul Harris in Chicago in 1905. After realizing they had the same business ethics and standards as Rotary International, they joined Rotary International and formed the "Sioux Falls Rotary Chapter".

About Rotary International District 5610

Rotary International District 5610 encompasses South Dakota, southwestern Minnesota, northwestern Iowa and northeastern Nebraska. There are 41 clubs located in District 5610. The purpose of the District is to administer Rotary International policies and advance the objects of Rotary in accordance with Rotary International Bylaws.
