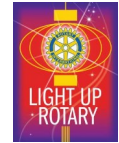

Randy Bartlett, an expert on invasive species, came to the Rotary Club of East Honolulu on October 6 and brought some "friends" along with him, a few coconut

rhinoceros beetles (CRBs). CRBs feed primarily on palm trees and have already destroyed fifty percent of the coconut palms on Guam.

Arriving on Oahu in December 2013 and currently found in the Honolulu Airport- Joint Base Pearl Harbor area, CRBs lay their eggs in mulch or compost. A 2 inch adult CRB will emerge from the mulch to fly to a palm and begin to feed.

Check out mulch or compost for larvae and your palms for damage and call 643 PEST.

And then.....there are the fire ants. The Big Island is experiencing a large infestation. If you think there are fire ants in your yard, go to LFA.org. for more information.

Currently we have 45 members of which 18 have donated so far this year.

**Rotary in Action.** More than one million Rotary members have donated their time and personal resources to end polio. Rotarians work with partners like UNICEF to prepare and distribute mass communication tools to share the message with those isolated by conflict, geography, or poverty. Rotary members also recruit fellow volunteers, assist with transporting the vaccine, and provide other logistical support.

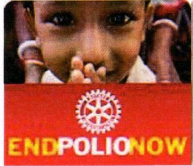
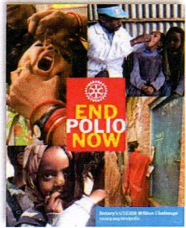
