On Monday, Kim Nguyen from the American Lung Association gave our Rotary Club of East Honolulu a brief history lesson of the association's commitment to lung health in America. The A.L.A. began in 1904 with an emphasis on tuberculosis treatment and prevention. In the 1950s, attention turned to smoking cessation. Today the association concerns itself

with the issues of asthma, bronchitis, and lung cancer. (There are still 145,000 smokers in Hawaii.)

Nguyen also provided the following statistics: lung disease is the third leading cause of death in the U.S.; more than 60% of Americans breathe unhealthy air inside and outside; and while the occurrence of lung cancer is higher in the male population, the death rate is higher for women.
