

Water, water everywhere! SheenRu Yong, a visiting artist with PlayBuilders of Hawaii, spoke to the club on Monday and shared with us details of a community collaborative theater project she is developing here called "Flood: Turn the Tide."

Yong, who is originally from St. Louis, has worked in Taiwan where a four-month workshop she initiated and lead resulted in a performance entitled "The Re-Source Project." She showed a video of participants, some professional dancers, some amateurs using sensory information to create the performance.

"If we share what's been given, what other possibilities can we create?" Yong asks. Water is a world resource, and in her current project, "Flood ...," she hopes to create a platform for conversation about issues surrounding water. She will do this through island-wide panels of community members, story circles, and other events to provide multiple means of expression. Performances of "Flood..." will be held in Hawaii in October and November of this year. Yong will then take the work to Taiwan.

How can we help? Young asks for our water stories as well as assistance with funding and facilities for rehearsal.
