It was a privilege to welcome Clint Shroeder as our guest speaker this past Monday.

While we all know Clint as our District 5000 Governor, our time together gave us some more insight into Clint, our neighbor and friend.

Briefly, Clint told us of his journey with Rotary beginning with his membership in the Loveland-Thompson Valley Club in Colorado. He relocated to Hawaii in 2005 and, from that day forward, his passion for Rotary, as well as his commitment to giving back to his community, has never wavered. Clint began his presentation by telling us the story of two seas; the Dead Sea and the Sea of Galilee. He reminded us that both take in water from the River Jordan but that's where the similarity ends.
