Roger Breisch was our guest speaker. He began by presenting the overall benefits of looking inward and analyzing who we are and how we present ourselves to the world. He spoke about coming to understand that our view of the world is colored by our

memory and that memory is rarely accurate. His point being that memory often captures only about 25% of actual events and perspective colors the rest. He suggested that we listen to other people's life viewpoints openly and, then, only after listening carefully to their opinions, should we question their - and our assumptions. It is through listening and asking questions that powerful new perspectives open up to both. He digressed and told us of his work on the suicide hotline and how really listening to depressed and suicidal people stimulates coaches to ask the right questions of the fragile callers. His emotional response to this good work was clearly evident to the audience and, we might add, gave weight to the value of his message to us. The bottom line? We are all, each of us, gifts to the world and our relationships benefit by asking others "questions that matter" and then listening, really listening, to other's answers.
