Professor Steve Harrow was our speaker in a far too short presentation summarized the following points: 1) "The United States government and the voters who put them in office to defend our national interests need to be better informed about the histories and societies with whom we are engaging, lest we find ourselves building yet another quagmire such as the ones we got

stuck with in Viet Nam and Iraq.

2) We need to formulate <u>a comprehensive long-term policy</u> <u>towards China</u> and not go around just 'putting out fires' every time something untoward happens, such as the latest hacking event that netted Bei-jing the files on about 90 million US citizens that were stored at the OMB.].

3) The Chinese government are gamblers in the sense that they will keep on pushing to see how far they can go before we call their bluff. And in the case of their encroachment upon the rights of their neighbors in the South China Sea and in the interests of free rights-of-passage in international waters and air-space [a traditional US policy, initiated under Thomas Jefferson], we need to call their bluff and refuse to recognize what are clearly unilateral and illegal acts. But this can only happen effectively as part of a clear, well-informed and well thought out overall strategy towards China."

In summary, the presentation was provocative and made me wonder just which Presidential candidate is the most knowledgeable in foreign policy. Look it up; I did. Steve deserved more of our time in order to fully develop his point-of-view. I suggest that we invite him back and explore this subject in more detail as; after all, Southeast Asian actions affect us all.
