We welcomed an especially interesting guest speaker, Kyle Apuna, who shared his experiences in

Bangkok, Thailand on behalf of the Thai Peace Foundation. He thanked the East Honolulu Rotary for their generous contributions to Thailand's small "Potong" community and told us how we helped them to overcome many challenges, not the least of which was the basic need of buying and installing a fire-fighting system to protect them from the very real dangers of fire in their small hometown. District grant money helped make a much needed fire fighting system and community center possible for the first time in this 38 year-old community. Moreover, our partnership with Kyle's NGO, the Thai Peace Foundation, invested in the leadership development of Potong's community leaders. Kyle, a remarkably articulate young man, has dedicated his life to the Foundations.
