DG Chet addressed the Board of Directors bringing us up to date on D5000 and Rotary International plans for the future. Emphasis was on membership how, when and where. The emphasis is on Corporate Membership through larger Corporations. There will be primary and secondary memberships. The District website now has yellow pages where different businesses are listed.
