Made in Hope is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization empowering women and children who have been rescued from the global sex trade (human trafficking and modern day slavery) to break the cycle of exploitation and secure their freedom by providing education, sustainable livelihood opportunities, and care in the healing process. Made in Hope also advocates for the still en-

slaved, increasing global awareness and mobilizing support. Their mission is founded in love of Jesus, who has a plan for each of us.

Current operations consists of two primary focuses.

- 1. Currently work with a non-governmental agency in Quezon City, Philippines that provides aftercare (healing and restoration) support to women who have been rescued from human trafficking. We also partner with them in a livelihood training program where we market handcrafts (in the US, mainly jewelry) that the women produce to help sustain themselves and that teaches them a trade that we hope will prevent them from returning to the street.
- 2. They bring awareness to the issues human trafficking globally, currently emphasis on the Philippines and the US as these are the areas that have the resources and support structures to apply their work. They are attempting to establish a "brand" in MADE IN HOPE that mobilizes others to share in bringing awareness and education to their communities and social circles. The are advocates for those who continue to be enslaved and cannot speak out for themselves.

Made in Hope is purely supported by donations and from sales of the handcrafts and logo wear. The funds go to resourcing programs for women and children that are escaping exploitation and/or who may be vulnerable to be trafficked due to poverty.
