

OUR MISSION







Three Piko Hawaiian Cultural Approach



- Piko 'ī: Po'o (head)
 - Ancestral connection to the past, to those that came before us and the value of Aloha
- Piko 'ō: Waena (central)
 - Naval connection to source of life, nutrition, health & wellness, and the value of Laulima.
- Piko 'ā: Ma'i (future)
 - Procreative connection to the future, to those that will come after us and the value of 'ike and kuleana.

What is Piko?





Piko:

- Navel or umbilical cord
- Summit or top of a hill, mountain
- Where a leaf connects to the stem
- A piko closely connects an individual to his/her kinship and genealogy
- Figuratively refers to the relationship between ancestors and descendants
- Connects us to the Past and to the Future
