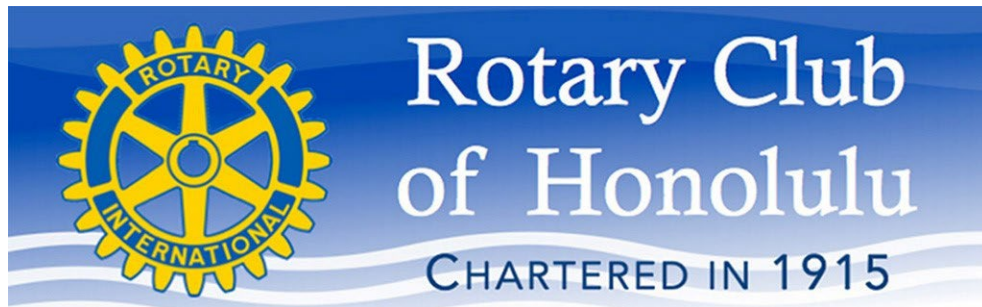




On September 3, 2024, a handful of our members and a few of their guests gathered at The Pantry for a light lunch before learning about this marvelous organization.

The Pantry is staffed by only three and is able to be successful in serving hundreds of families and community members every month, through the gracious and generous time given by volunteers – all giving Service Above Self!

Volunteers fill boxes full of food and dry goods (when available). Wednesdays and Fridays are the distribution days.

The Pantry serves Keiki, Kupuna, ALICE, and the disabled. Fresh local eggs and frozen chicken are in high demand, along with fresh produce, and provided. The boxes are custom packed based on the orders submitted by those being served.

51% of the food comes from the Hawaii Food Bank. If you have donated to them, you have also assisted The Pantry. The Pantry supports local business by purchasing the fresh produce locally.

The facility is well kept; clean and runs smoothly! It was “grocery style shopping” but with such a large growth in population served, the pre-packed boxes became necessity.
