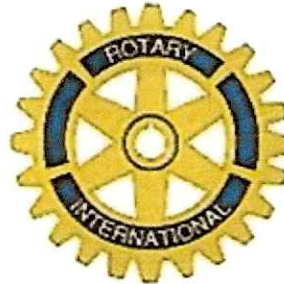




ROTARY CLUB OF HONOLULU
CAMP ERDMAN WORK WEEKEND
MAY 3 & 4, 2025



We will continue our tradition of a spring work project weekend that has drawn more than 100 participants by involving Rotarians plus inviting the broader community to join us. The Rotary Club of Honolulu will provide \$14,000 and the Camp Erdman Budget will match that so going in we will have \$28,000 to work with. Among other things, we currently plan to build 25 picnic benches for Rotary Village and other camp locations, install heat extraction fans in all Rotary Village cabins, place a gravel buffer zone around the cabins for fire protection and other miscellaneous tasks. No special skills are required to be useful to the project. Invite anyone who might like to join us for a weekend at camp

Participants may choose to work on just Saturday, just Sunday or both days. We encourage both days. You may choose to spend Friday and/or Saturday night in a camp cabin or drive to the camp each day. If you stay bring your own pillow, sheets and towel. Camp will provide us meals in their dining hall Friday dinner through Sunday Lunch. Here is our schedule:
