DRESS CODE

All members and their guests shall comply with the dress standards of the Club. This dress code pertains to men, women, and children. Business, Business Casual, Aloha Attire, and/or Dress Jeans are acceptable. The following are NOT acceptable in the Main Dining Room, Foyer, and all member areas on the main level including the Card Room Bar (except when accessed via the Mauka entrance) and Library: slippers, go-aheads (zoris), athletic shoes, shorts, t shirts, knit pullovers and tank tops. Jeans are only permitted in good condition (clean, no holes).

ATTIRE DEFINED

Business

Men: matching suit or sports jacket with contrasting trousers, long or short-sleeved dress shirt with/without tie, appropriate dress shoes.

Women: business suit, contrasting skirt/slacks and jacket, dress or skirt and dress blouse with appropriate dress shoes.

Business Casual

Men: clean and neatly pressed trousers, dress shirts, sport shirts, golf/polo shirts with collar and appropriate footwear.

Women: clean and neatly pressed slacks, skirts, dress shirts and blouses, sweater type tops and appropriate footwear.

Aloha Wear

Men: clean and neatly pressed aloha shirts with appropriate trousers and footwear.

Women: clean and tasteful muumuus, dresses, aloha shirts with appropriate slacks or skirts and footwear.

Dress Jeans

Effective 09/2024 – Jeans are permitted in the Main Clubhouse. Jeans must be in good taste with no holes, frayed cuffs, or other obvious signs of wear. Dress shirts or blouses are still required.
