



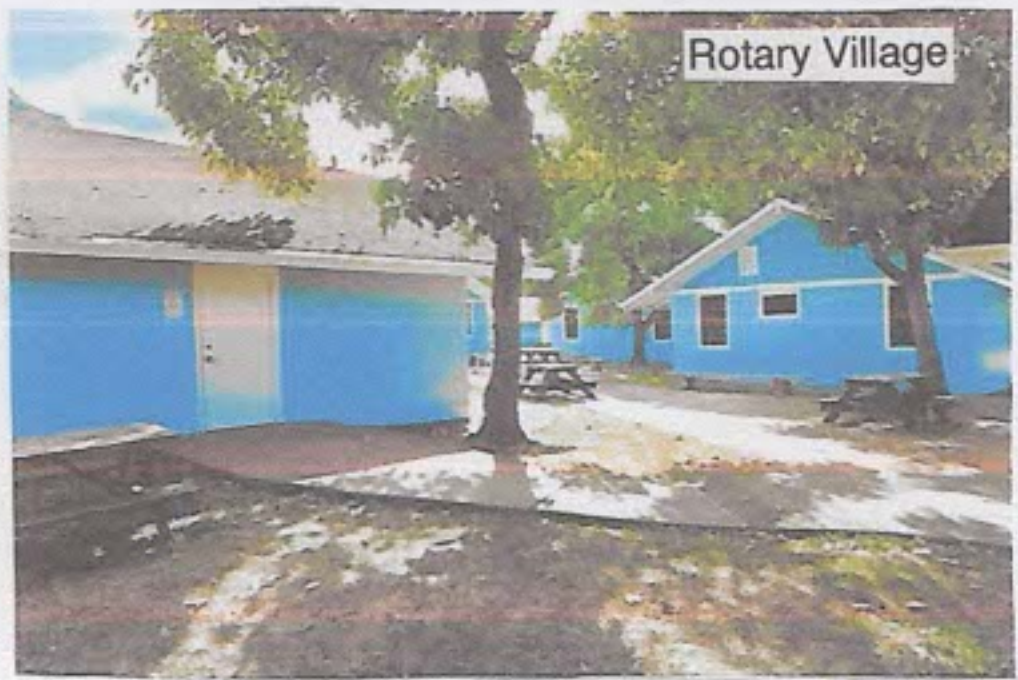
**ROTARY CLUB OF HONOLULU

On May 1 -2, 2006 we continue our tradition of a spring work weekend at YMCA Camp Erdman. By involving Rotary Club of Honolulu members plus Rotarians from other clubs, YMCA young people, US Military personnel and other community members we have drawn more than 100 participants in past years. The Rotary Club of Honolulu is providing \$12,000 and the YMCA will match that amount so we will have \$24,000 to work with. We plan to paint Rotary Hall, cabins and other facilities. Other work will include carpentry projects, laying a stone pathway and removal of encroaching brush. No special skills are required to be useful to the project. Feel free to invite anyone who might like to Join us'

Participants may choose to work just Saturday, just Sunday or both days. We encourage both days. You may spend Friday and/or Saturday night in a camp cabin or drive to camp each day. If you stay in a cabin please bring toilet articles, a pillow, sheets and a towel with you, The camp will provide meals Friday dinner through Sunday lunch. Lodging and meals are provided at no cost.
