IHS- **James Pierce** - serving the evening meal to the homeless-every quarter - twice a year at the men's shelter, and twice a year at the women's shelter. HOOMAKUA PROJECT - **Stephen Nikkola**. Mentoring young fathers, recently released from incarceration. PEARL HAVEN- A District wide initiative to develop a home for rescued sex-trafficked women and girls... **Lyla Berg** is our liaison to help get this project going- initially we are working on developing a SERENITY GARDEN. IN DEVELOPMENT - two new members NATIONAL ALLIANCE ON MENTAL ILLNESS - NAMI- **Beth Ann Kozlovich**- a fund-raising walk at the end of October. RESPONSIVE CAREGIVERS OF HAWAII -**Michael Marsh**, possibly with other Rotary Clubs to develop an outreach program. Lastly, GOV. IGE'S HAWAII STATE WWI CENTENNIAL TASK FORCE - Rotary, as a 100 year-old organization to be an exhibitor in the WWI Centennial Museum on Nov. 11, 2018 at the Natatorium.

International Service. **Hai Cha Lambert** is working on the upcoming Nepal Project, working with 2 underprivileged schools. Past project included Philippines, Myanmar and Korea. Future projects may involve Thailand.

President Bub wrapped up the meeting by saying the club's membership is our top priority this year. He quoted a Chinese proverb – 'Pearls don't lie on the sea shore. You must dive for them'. We must make a conscious effort to recruit more business leaders to our club.
