

## Agreement of Sisterclub between The Rotary Club of Pusan and The Rotary Club of Honolulu

## I. Objective

- IV. Both Pusan and Honolulu Rotary Clubs reserve the right to enter into any sister club agreement with any other Rotary Club during the effective period of this agreement.
- 1996 at the weekly club meeting of the Rotary Club of Honolulu, this sister club agreement will signed and exchanged.
- VI. Both parties shall report the event of this sister club agreement to their respective district governor office.
