



Mutual Agreement

- (a) The parties mutually agree to regularly exchange club bulletins, membership directories and other publications suitable to achieving the stated purpose.
- (b) The parties also mutually agree to exchange information related to their respective activities and to report this information to members through their bulletins.

- (d) Members of each club will extend business and sightseeing assistance to visitors from the other club, as much as possible.
- (e) Members of each club will discuss and consider joining together in pursuing various service projects that will facilitate the accomplishment of the stated purpose.
- (f) Members of each club will discuss and consider adopting exchange, travel, educational and other similar programs involving Rotarian members of the respective clubs as well as their children and grandchildren.
