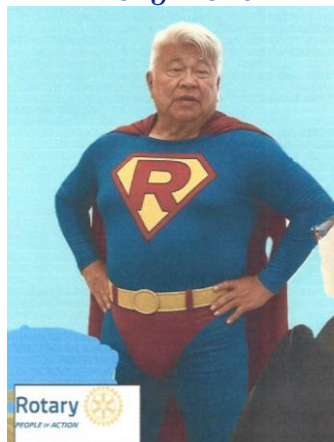

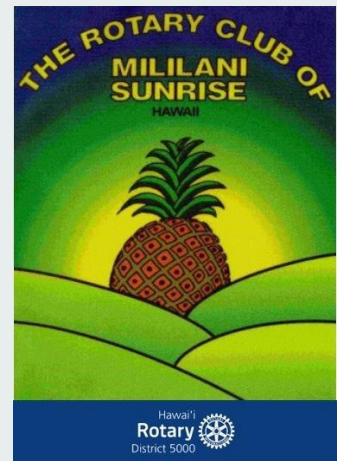

In 1979, Nancy began her real estate career. In 1984, she opened a one-woman office in Hilo called Day-Lum, Inc. Her company grew into a major rental and property management company known as Day-Lum Rentals and Management, Inc. In addition, in 1995, she became the owner of the full-service sales franchise known as Coldwell Banker Day-Lum Properties located in Hilo, Hawai'i. Jus this year, she sold her company and is now looking forward to “retirement.”

Nancy joined the Rotary Club of Hilo in 1988 (37 years) and was the club's first female member. Some members left to create another club since the idea of women as members was “too new” and idea. Nancy eventually became Club President during the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the club.

Nancy's family was incredibly involved in the equestrian activities of the Big Island, and she has ridden as a Pa'u Queen and Princess in various island parades. Her late husband, Alvin “Al” Cabral, dedicated 28 years of his life to the improvement of the Pana'ewa Equestrian Center in Hilo, Hawai'i. Her youngest son is a professional cowboy and lives on the mainland.

We are lucky to have Nancy as our New District Governor for District 5000, as she brings a cheerful outlook, a warm and welcoming spirit, and love to talk story with ANYONE.
