PART 2, Page 2+: PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 2.1 What leadership responsibilities have you had during your high school career? (ie. sports, clubs, groups, activities)
- 2.2 Do you plan on running for any school offices next year? If so, which ones?
- 2.3 What has been your involvement in school, religious or community activities?
- 2.4 List any awards you have received and/or achievements you have accomplished in your school and/or community.
- 2.5 What are your goals, career plans and ambitions?

PART III, Page 3: ESSAY (PLEASE DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THIS PAGE)

Describe a significant experience, achievement, risk you have taken, or ethical dilemma you have faced and its impact on you, personally and academically.

Essay Criteria:

- The essay should be double spaced, **250-300** words.
- Correct grammar, punctuation and spelling are important.
- You will be scored on what you have to say and how well you say it.
- You may use personal anecdotes, personal interviews and personal observations to illustrate your points.
- Any student who does not follow the essay criteria could be disqualified.

Complete all three parts and submit in ONE file as a WORD document to: polly@pollysmithblackwell.com. (Any other file format will be returned for resubmission.) Please ask your guidance counselor for assistance if needed. Send a copy to your counselor as well so they have a record of your submission. **PLEASE DO NOT USE AN ON-LINE/DOWNLOAD PROCESS - SEND DIRECT BY EMAIL.**

DUE: FRIDAY, June 14, 2019 (files received after this date will not be accepted)

Your form/essay will be read and scored over the summer. You will be contacted in late August only IF you are rated in the Top 10. The Youth Salute awards luncheon for ALL participants will be held October 8, 2019.
