## August 24, 2022

- 1. President Petri called the meeting, held in the Whitnall School District Community Room, to order at 7:04 a.m.

- 2. Secretary's report (Delke)

--12% had no preference about meeting times, 53% wanted to keep the arrangement as is, 1% wanted all breakfast meetings, and 2% wanted all evening meetings

--12% of respondents reported they rarely attend meetings, 59% would attend regardless of the meeting time, and 18% would attend more often if the meetings were in the evening

- --Petri noted that the WIFI at Diamond Jim's does not work.

- --Costs at Diamond Jim's are approximately \$350 per meeting which includes a room use fee
- --Discussion about possibility that meal costs are a deterrent for new persons joining the club

--Possible solution is to use 50% of the proceeds of the Christmas auction to offset meal costs for new members. Next agenda
