Roughly 5 years in development, this space opens up an outdoor classroom for the Muskego-Norway School District. Positioned between the southern edge of the athletic facilities and the city's Engel Preserve, the project reclaimed 12 acres of unused wetlands.

The high school science club did several seed collections from the Engel Preserve, which were used to restore vegetation natural to the area.

The process included several killings and removal of invasive vegetation. Drain tile was used to control the large amount of water into 2 pond areas. Swamp white oak trees were planted. Paths have been cut through the area. There have also been several Boy Scout Eagle and Girl Scout Gold projects to enhance the projected use by District students.

Thanks to the Muskego Norway School District, the City of Muskego, US Fish & Wildlife in the assistance of this project.

DIRECTIONS: Classroom is southwest of the high school. Take either Janesville Rd, or Woods Rd., west to Racine Ave. Go west on Woods to the last athletic field parking lot. Enter that lot and go to the southwest corner. Walk along the blacktop south to the classroom. You may want a chair to relax while listening to School District people & club members
