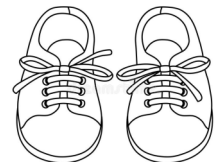

#### FROM JUNE 16 MEETING

- Rotary Circle at Boerner Gardens: bridge widening and strengthening is underway. Refreshing the landscaping at the Circle, adding more pavers to the circle, installing a new waterfall pump, and expanding the water retention area will happen soon. When this is done, there will be \$13,000 in the WPRC Foundation park fund. People are still purchasing memorial bricks.
- We sponsored 5 students from Kathmandu, Nepal to attend the virtual **World Affairs Seminar**. Pranisha Katuwai (female), Rasna Pradhan (female), Sambhrant Pyakurel (male), Samriddhi Shrestha (female), Shrimika Bharati (female) were recruited by Dr. Suman Nupan and Dr. Barbara Engebretsen (Wayne State University). Nepal has sent students to previous WAS events. No area students were interested in attending this event, so we again donated the \$1300 to WAS.

WAS is an annual week-long international student leadership conference. which discusses the ways in which young leaders can promote change and become involved in finding solutions to a world problem —“Hunger in a World of Plenty.”.
