### **New Rotary Peace Center**

Otto & Fran Walter Foundation pledged \$1.5 million to start a Rotary Peace Center in the Middle East or North Africa. The center will offer a professional development certificate focused on peacebuilding and development issues in the region to up to 40 students each year.

#### Rotary, Malaria & Zambia

\$2 million grants from Rotary Foundation, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation and World Vision USA allow Partners for a Malaria Free Zambia to train 380 health facility staff members plus equip and train 2500 new community health workers. Equipment includers rapid diagnostic test kits, anti-malaria medicine, finger prick lancets, educational materials, bicycles, mobile phones. Local and national information will be regularly updated and there will be ongoing support for the local workers. The project will reduce malaria cases by 90% in the 10 selected districts.
