DECEMBER BOARD MEETING highlights:

++Preliminary discussion about meal food costs in 2022. They're higher than anticipated. No change will be made before the second quarterly bill.

++Heard report from Tom Hermann (area high schools vocational & apprenticeship coordinator) shared information to facilitate the decision about the vocational/ trades/ apprenticeship scholarships and the small grant program for those persons. Committee will create the application form for the two \$500 scholarships and definition pages; plus the application form and definitions pages for the \$1000 grants fund which will facilitate purchase of initially required tools/ equipment for vocational/trades/ apprenticeship people with financial need. Board will approve the forms and procedures in January.

++There will be a theatre social event for members and families in February or March

++Approved an additional \$2973 for the El Salvador project. This completes the funding for phase 3 of the project. The project can go forward. Come to the January 5 meeting to learn about this Global Grant project.

++Christmas auction netted \$1043 for the 2 charities. Variety received \$631; Waukesha Community Fund received \$400. The rest covered processing fees.
