Invisible in plain sight -- that's what it often means to be homeless in our society. Nowhere to go and no voice to be heard. We advocate to local government services on behalf of our friends in need.

Every Tuesday, Thursday & Sunday evening, our team takes to the street to distribute life sustaining needs (food, water, clothing, hygiene items, blankets, and other necessities) to our most vulnerable population — Milwaukee County's homeless population. Street Angels is often the first responder to those in a homeless crisis and acts as an extension cord to vital shelter/housing resources

A daytime "standing" outreach in partnership with the Greenfield Fire Department, City of Greenfield, Salvation Army and other organizations. This outreach takes place on Tuesdays from 10am-noon at 2900 W Cold Spring Road (Salvation Army).
