- **Treasurer's report: 5 members are \$2300 behind in dues payments
- **Festival Foods HC Brat Stand July 17 & August 14 fundraisers
- **Approve the Coats for Kids District Grant proposal
- **Donated to the 4 public library Summer Reading Programs,\$100 to each public high school robotics club, creating 32 care packages for Milwaukee homeless youth who use Pathfinders. Grant of \$250 covers contents; Petri family donating \$5 McDonald's cards & Nolan donating \$5 Burger King cards to include with the packages.
