Rather than implementing projects itself in a given country, Global Partnership of Education brings together stakeholders from the public & private sectors around a national education plan; and it channels funding from private donors and governments to help finance those plans. Each country's plan is tailored to its specific needs and aligned with the local education plan supported by the government. In turn, partner countries are encouraged to allocate 20 percent of their domestic budget to education. Ultimately, GPE's goal is for local governments to take responsibility for fully funding a plan that delivers 12 years of schooling, plus a year of preschool, to every girl and boy.

In the early stages of the partnership, Rotary hopes to engage members in three to five countries that are already part of the GPE network. Activities will differ depending on the specific needs within each country. Mary Jo Jean-Francois, Rotary International's area of focus manager for basic education and literacy, says Rotarians could play a key role in helping families understand what educational resources from GPE are available to their communities, and in conveying to governments what kind of educational assistance those communities need most.
