GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP

Rotary District 6270 is pleased to announce the availability of a Global Grant Scholarship for matriculation in the fall of 2022 or spring of 2023.

The amount of the scholarship is USD \$30,000 and must be used for graduate school studies outside the United States. Applicants must be residents of the geographic area of District 6270 or attending an undergraduate school in the geographic area. In addition, a proposed program of study must be closely aligned with one of Rotary's seven "Areas of Focus."

Deadlines are as follow:

September 1, 2021 – Application form available

January 14, 2022 – Complete Application deadline (submit online February 5, 2022 - In-Person or Zoom Interviews scheduled. An in-person interview is preferred.

February 14, 2022 – Successful Scholar Notified (for matriculation in 2022-2023 academic year.)
