Powerline Trail



The Powerline Trail is the first section of the Route of the Badger. It is a major new east-west shared-use path that provides significant recreation and transportation opportunity to the public. The trail will allow users to walk, run or bike for exercise and transportation. It will connect them to homes, businesses, workplaces, parks and the existing Milwaukee County Oak Leaf Trail system.

This phase of the new path will begin with a connection to the established Oak Leaf Trail at 105th and Cold Spring Road, and will extend east within the WE Energies power line corridor to 60th Street. The corridor is located between Howard Avenue and Cold Spring Road in Greenfield. Ultimately the trail will continue all the way to Lake Michigan as well as north into West Allis.

The Powerline Trail will pass through a densely populated area, connecting neighborhoods with commercial, civic and recreational destinations. The following community destinations are located less than ¼ mile north or south of the corridor: City hall and Community Center, 4 churches, 3 grocery stores, 3 parks, 5 restaurants, 3 retail stores, 2 schools and many retail establishments.
