The recent detection of the poliovirus type 2 in New York is a stark reminder that as long as polio exists anywhere, it is a threat everywhere. It also highlights the importance of vaccination as the only form of protection against polio and other vaccine-preventable diseases and the work that needs to be done in our communities to encourage the uptake of vaccines.

The U.S. is still considered low risk for paralytic outbreaks of polio due to the high level of vaccine coverage across the population. If a child has received the entire course of vaccines, the risk of becoming paralyzed by polio is negligible

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 92.6% of U.S. children aged 24 months are fully vaccinated against polio, slightly below the 95% World Health Organization target.
