From the August 24 Board meeting

- ◇ SurveyMonkey: 88% said 3 meetings were enough. 53% said to keep the meeting times as they are & 29% wanted the three meetings to be after hours. 59% said they would come regardless of the times & 18% said they would attend after hours meetings & 12% said they rarely attend. No change to the times is indicated.
- ◇ There's a concern by potential members about costs. Should we make food free for new members during the first year as an encouragement to the potential members and to remove one possible initial concern? If they try us ... they'll like us.
- ◇ Should we move to an after hours location with adequate WIFI?
- ◇ Mini grant for education:
 - \$1000 is budgeted amount for this new program
 - Cap individual grants at \$200
 - Have four application deadlines during the year
 - Send application information to the Greendale, Greenfield and Whitnall School Districts.
 - Go to the school to present the check to the teacher (photo opportunity)
- ◇ Explored some Christmas for youth opportunities
- ◇ China Lights volunteer sign-up will use Sign-up genius. Will try to recruit some high school students to assist during China Lights.
