Tepeaqu Water Project

The Rotary International Global Grant project, that our club has been involved with in Tepeaqu, El Salvador, has had 3 phases. The estimated total cost of the project will be \$280,000.

In phase 1 a well was drilled for the needed water.

Phase 2 provided the necessary piping and equipment to supply 150 households with water. Local residents were trained to maintain the system.

Phase 3 includes additional households in the community with piping plus building 260 latrines and some management projects.

We have partnered with the Rotary Club of South Salvador and Atonement Lutheran Church. The project has been very challenging due to a number of reasons. [*Language is just one.*]

As of this date, the final Global Grant has been fully funded and has been sent to Rotary International for approval. Once approved, funds can be forwarded to RI and then on to El Salvador

Teotepeque is a municipality in the La Libertad department of El Salvador. The name Teotepeque comes from the Nahuatl word for "Mountain of God."
