The Global Polio Eradication Initiative was informed of a case of paralytic polio in an unvaccinated individual in Rockland County, New York.

The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention are coordinating with New York State health authorities on their investigation. Initial sequencing confirmed by CDC indicates that the case is type 2 VDPV.

Any form of poliovirus anywhere is a threat to children everywhere. It is critical that the GPEI Polio Eradication Strategy 2022-2026 is fully resourced and fully implemented everywhere, to ensure a world free of all forms of poliovirus can be achieved.

We are calling on every single Rotarian to take action and be a part of the fight to end polio, helping to raise \$50 million per vear for polio eradication.

This brings home the need for the polio eradication efforts. td
