**Ukranians:** Over a million people have fled Ukraine and are in dire need of emergency aid. The United Nations estimates that number could grow to 5 million people displaced.

In response to the deepening humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, The Rotary Foundation has created an official channel for Rotary members to contribute funds to support the relief efforts underway and has designated its Disaster Response Fund as the main avenue for contributions. Funds must be received by RIF by April 30 and list Disaster Relief Fund.
