## Polio and Rotary

As a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we've reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.

Rotary members have contributed more than \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries from this paralyzing disease. Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by governments to contribute more than \$10 billion to the effort.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year

1894 1st documented polio outbreak in New Jersey.  
1955 Jonas Salk develops a vaccine  
1960 Albert Sabin develops a vaccine  
1979 Rotary begins its efforts to eliminate polio  
1994 Polio eliminated from the Americas  
1995 165 million children in China and India are immunized in 1 week  
2000 550 million children (10% of the world's population) receive a polio vaccine

\$3 is the average cost to protect a child from polio
